## 2023 Klamm Niederhausen "In der Rossel" Riesling GG

Classified as a GG site from the very beginning, we allowed the vineyard time to develop, and now it can present a worthy VDP.GROSSES GEWÄCHS. Our cellar team is convinced: 'One of the best wines in the cellar of Gut Hermannsberg.' The intensely mineral and citrus aromas give this GG an impressive complexity. The subtle herbal aromas are perfectly complemented by a lively acidity structure and salinity. On the palate, there is a balanced interplay of citrus and herbal spice. The finish is taut and firm, with depth and a very long aftertaste.

## We recommend it with light summer dishes such as seafood salad, steamed fish, or a fresh salad plate.

**Origin:** The south and southeast-facing site warms up quickly during the day and cools down significantly at night. Riesling thrives on this contrast. The soil is characterized by a unique complexity, containing elements that do not typically occur together. This is due to highly active volcanic earth movements—carboniferous slate and volcanic porphyry. These conditions provide an exceptional environment for an extraordinary, complex, elegant, and mineral Riesling.
